

The Dick Howser Center follows research-based practice in routines for infants. Routines should be consistent, yet flexible to accommodate each child's individual temperament and pace. Schedules (daily sequence of events such as choice play opportunities, lunch, outdoor time) and routines (caregiver



interactions during eating, napping and bodily care) provide the repetitive patterns very young children need to develop a sense of security in out of home care. Infants eat, sleep, and play according to their own rhythms rather than set schedules. All infants are diapered as needed, rather than on a schedule. During inclement weather, infants will not go outside. Instead they will be given indoor opportunities for "tummy time" and gross motor activities.
